

NATIONAL CANINE HEALTH & WELLBEING COMMITTEE

CHARTER

- 1. The primary objective is to work towards the reduction of canine hereditary diseases in Australia.
- 2. To establish and maintain liaison on matters pertaining to hereditary diseases with
 - (a) Member Bodies of ANKC Ltd and their Hereditary Diseases Committees where established.
 - (b) National Breed Councils
 - (c) Overseas Canine Controls
 - (d) Other organisations and people working in the field of canine hereditary diseases where desirable.
- 3. To act as the National Advisory Body on canine hereditary diseases.
- 4. To make recommendations to ANKC Ltd on policy and other matters relating to canine hereditary diseases and the reduction of their incidence.
- 5. To co-ordinate activities of ANKC Ltd Member Bodies relating to hereditary diseases.
- 6. To conduct and promote education programmes aimed at reducing the incidence of canine hereditary diseases and, where desirable, to initiate and implement such action programmes.
- 8. To develop and maintain a reference data bank on canine hereditary diseases on a breed by breed basis together with modes of inheritance where established, including a separate register of diseases known to have occurred in Australia.
